Alumni, here's an invitation to stay involved!

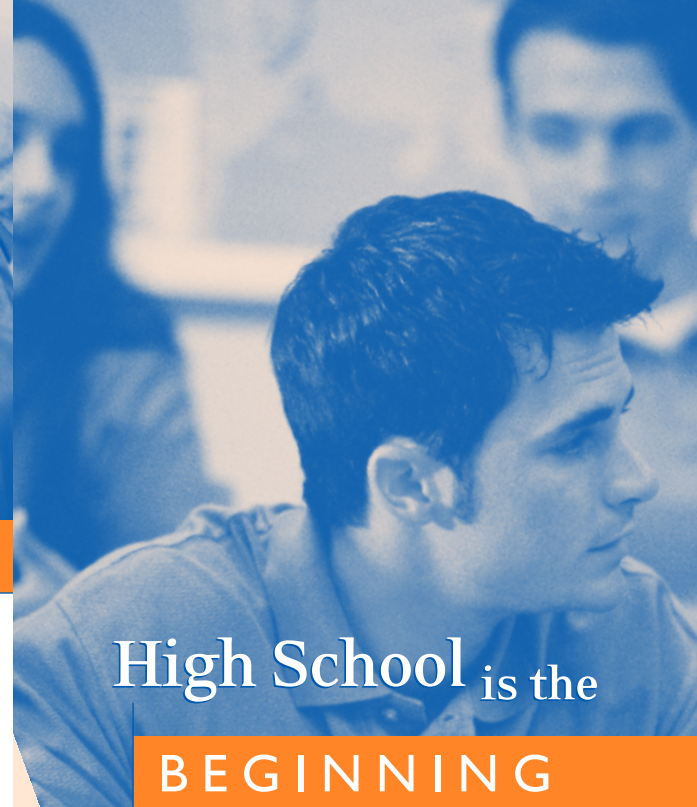
